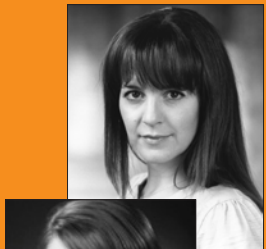

Thursday 7th May, 7.00pm; St Mary's Church *Young Musicians' Concert*

The young musicians and singers from Ashwell School, The Knight's Templar School and St. Mary's Junior Choir will perform a varied programme of instrumental and choral pieces. It is always a pleasure to attend this free concert and witness their enthusiasm and budding talent.

This will be followed by *Sung Compline*, an ancient plainsong service, sung by the gentlemen of St. Mary's Church Choir. A peaceful and moving end to the day.

She now sings full-time with English National Opera at the Coliseum.

The concert will consist of a horn and piano recital followed by Brahms horn trio. Ben will be accompanied by Nicola Goldscheider (violin) and James Sherlock (pianist) both acclaimed professional musicians.
